Leading hand allowance – in charge of 3-10 employees	\$0.95 per hour up to a maximum of \$35.98 per week
Leading hand allowance – in charge of 11-19 employees	\$1.42 per hour up to a maximum of \$53.97 per week
Meal allowance	\$13.78 for a meal
Stand-by allowance - Monday to Friday	\$13.49 per period
Stand-by allowance - Saturday, Sunday and public holidays	\$28.78 per period
Tool allowance	\$0.14 per hour, up to a maximum of \$5.43 per week
Vehicle allowance	\$0.80 per km
Vaccinations reimbursement	reimbursement for the cost of receiving vaccinations
